Locate the countries of: - North America (Canada, Jamaica, Mexico, USA).	Understand: - Hemispheres - lines of latitude, - Lines of longitude, - Greenwich Meridian - Prima Meridian - Time zones (including day and night). Name and locate geographical regions of the UK (coastal regions) and their identifying human and physical characteristics (cliffs, beaches). Name and locate key topographical features of the UK and the world (coastal, forests). Understand how some characteristics of the UK have changed over time.
